Three Ways to Sell Honey

- Non-Food Establishments
 - Home Based Vendor (HBV)
- Food Establishments
 - Retailer
 - Wholesaler

Home Based Vendor

- Indiana Code 16-42-5-29 (2009)
 - Named HEA 1309
 - Section 29 Vendor
- Direct Person to Person
- May Only Sell at
 - Road Side Stands
 - Place along road where **you** sell **your** products.
 - Farmers Markets

HBV Label

- Your name and address
- Ingredients
- Net weight, grams and ounces
- Date food was processed
- 10 point type:

"This product is home produced and processed and the production area has not been inspected by the State Department of Health."

Wholesale Food Establishments

- **410 IAC 7-21**
- Complete
 - "Registration Application for Wholesale Distributor"
- Rules can be reviewed at:

- No Taste Testing Allowed
- Work with the State Health Dept

Retail Food Establishments

- 410 IAC 7-24
- Purchase a Retail License
- Bottle in an Inspected Kitchen

- Work w/Your Local Health Dept
- Any taste testing may require additional license
